Hooray for spring! We will celebrate the warmer weather with a month of family fun time.

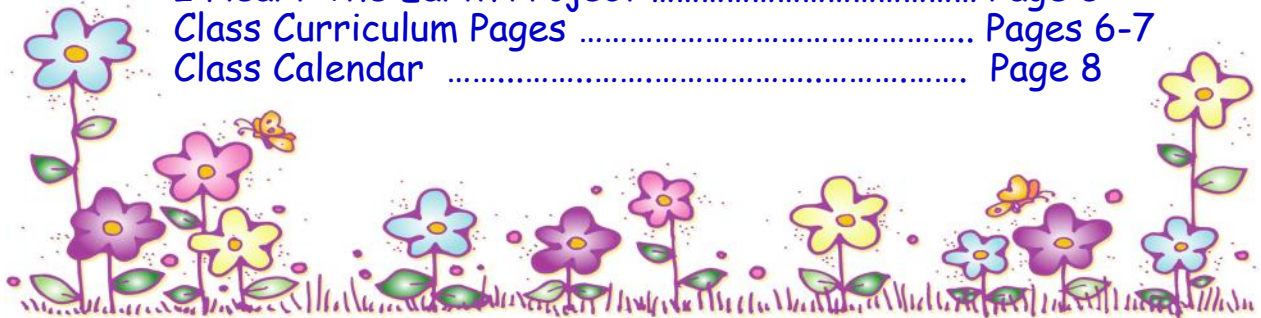
There will be many outdoor activities planned. Class trips have been planned among other fun events for our Children's House and Elementary classes.

Some suggestions would be through recycling, planting trees and flowers, composting, etc... We will be excited to hear what your family

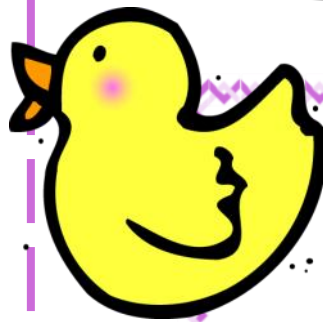
Don't Forget!

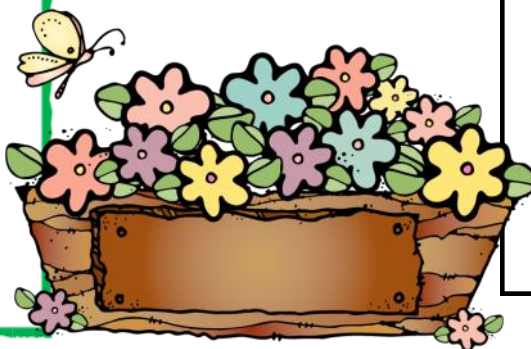

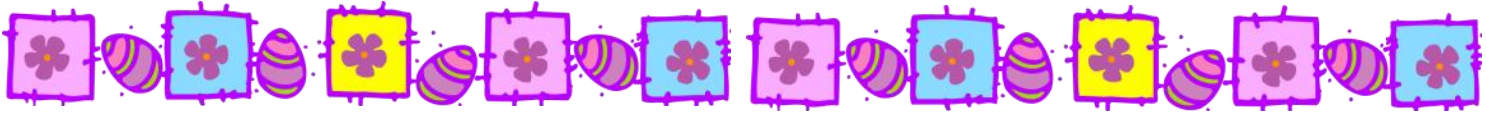

Remind your student to carry their seed collection to school on Monday, April 28, 2025

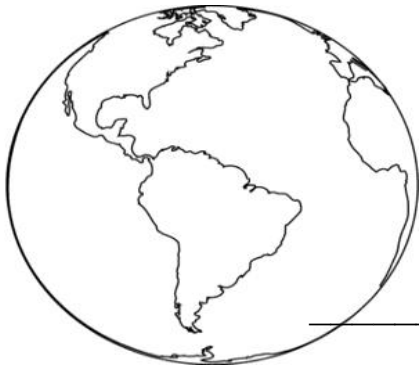
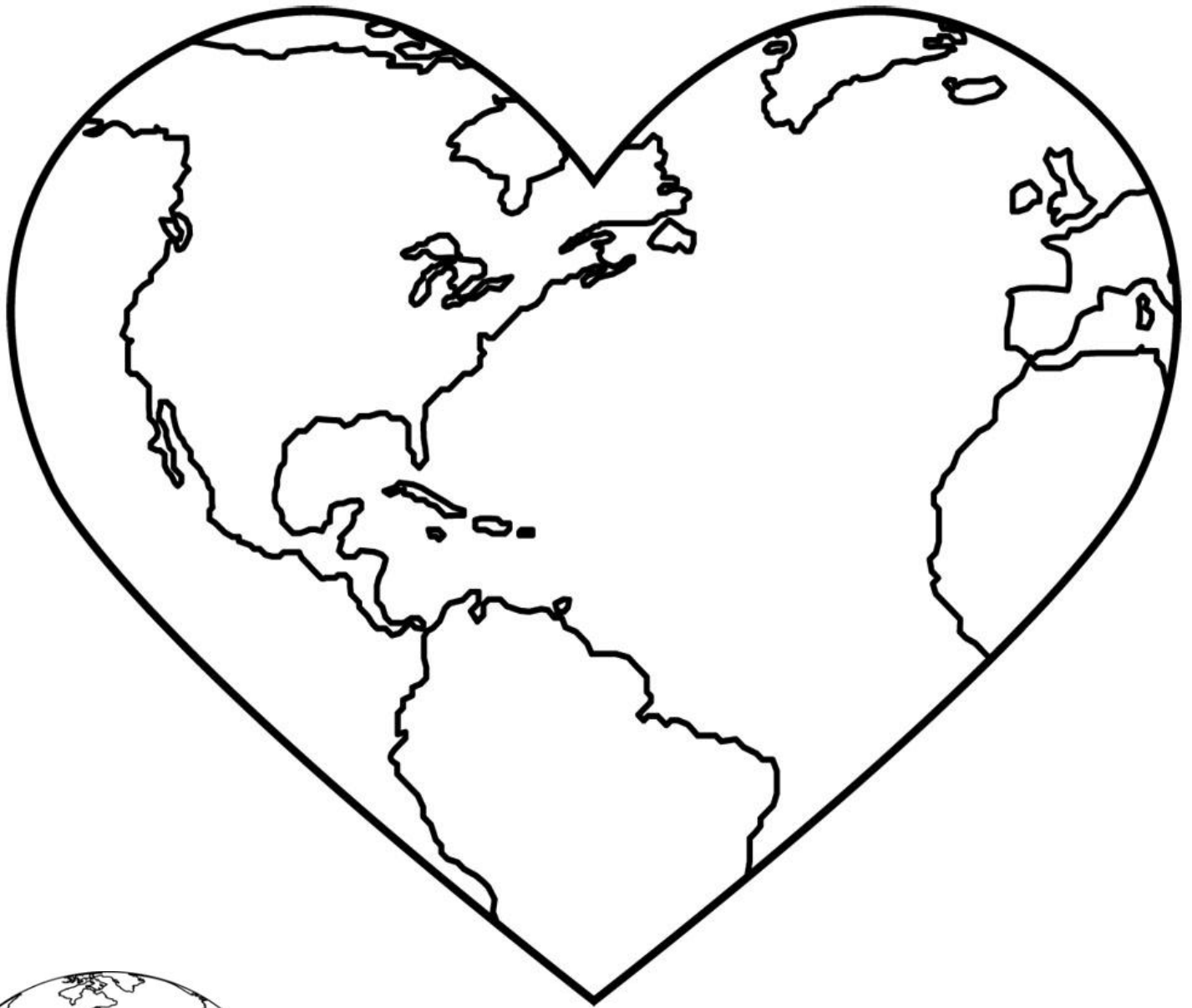
Your student will be sharing their collection with their class throughout the rest of the week.
