



During the month of January the GMS students are encouraged to color the snowflakes as they complete the tasks.


These are fun family building activities that the whole family will enjoy -

We will be displaying all of our "Cool Snow people" in the school entry over the next week for all to enjoy.


Be sure to put your name on your snowperson if you wish to have it returned to you.
