




During the month of January the GMS students are encouraged to color the snowflakes as they complete the tasks.



Be sure to put your name on your snowperson if you wish to have it returned to you.



Character Traits are qualities or characteristics of a person or character.
Character traits describe what a person is like on the inside. We can determine a person's character traits by their actions, thoughts, and words.

Our Character Building Classes this month will include the topic of **Honesty**.
