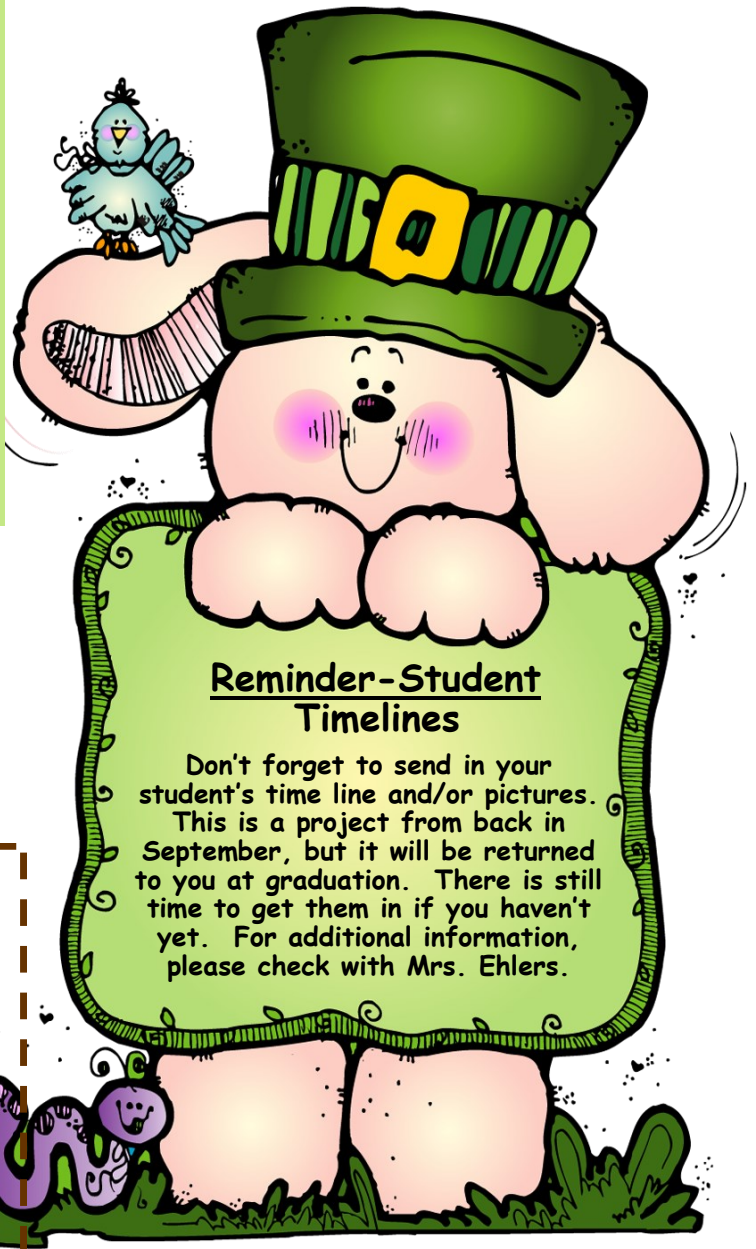
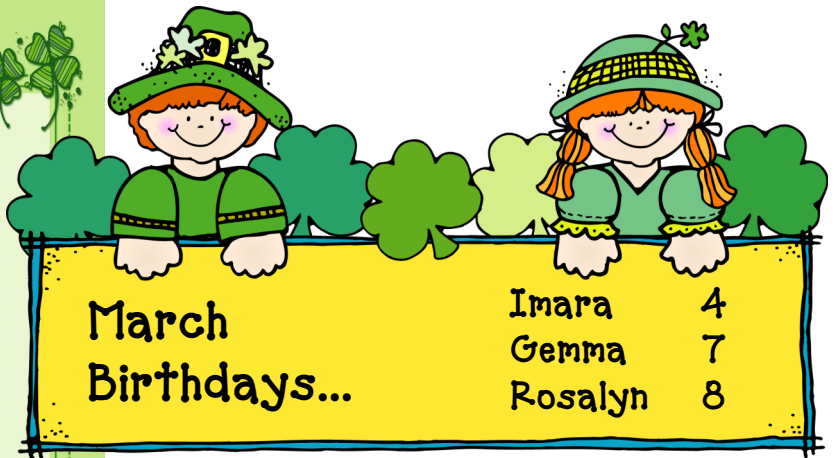

OPTION #2:

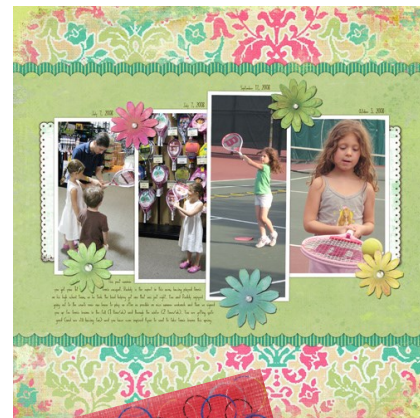
