
To some we say welcome! To others, it is welcome back! Either way, we are so excited to share this new school year with you and your family.

Student Personal Items

Please help the teachers and staff by keeping your student's personal items you send to school to a minimum. Storage is limited and a special request for additional items will be sent home if something comes up. Thanks so much for your assistance and please ask if you have any questions.

School Drop-Off and Pick Up Procedure

The beginning and end of the day can be a little chaotic and confusing for some, so we like to keep things as consistent as possible. We appreciate your patience.

At drop-off, please enter the school and sign your student in. Clock your student in on the computer provided in the entryway. A personal code will be issued to those on your

> pick-up list. Please make goodbye's brief and in the entryway. Students should go to their classrooms independently.

At pick-up, please enter the school and clock your student out on the computer provided. Students will be called and meet you in the entry to go home.

State regulations require a signature of the person dropping off and picking up as well.

A staff member will be available at the school office to assist both at drop-off

and pick-up. If you have a need to go beyond the entryway, please wait for a staff member to assist you.

Automatic Monthly Billing

The school offers automatic monthly billing for tuition and/or care charges to be automatically deducted from the bank account of your choice. Many of our families already enjoy this convenient service. If you have not yet taken advantage of Automatic Billing and would like to, please ask at the office for paperwork. If you have any further questions, please check with Mrs. White.

This service is optional and those signing up in September will begin auto drafts in October!

<u>Let's Go Paperless!</u>

This year our families have two ways to cut down on the clutter entering their homes! This newsletter is available electronically through the CMS website and families may elect to receive an email notification when the newsletter becomes available. Also families have the option to receive e-statements instead of paper ones. Watch for a survey form to be sent home and sign up for these great services.

Sunscreen Regulations

Because of the Department of Children, Youth and Family Services regulations, we are required to have paperwork and documentation of sunscreen and its application the same as for any medication.

If you want your child to have sunscreen applied at school, you will need to bring in the sunscreen and a signed medication release form to the school office.



Please note that sunscreen will only be applied after 11 am and in the afternoons, so you will need to sunscreen your child before they arrive at school in the morning. Thanks for your help and support.

Introduction to Capital Montessori Staff


Dear CMS Families,

Sorry, there is no child care available after 4:30 pm.


Families are asked to bring the following:

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
